Application

The compensating cable KN 9 L-S $2 \times 1,5 \text{ mm}^2$ is a PVC insulated cable which transmits the thermoelectric voltage of NiCr/Ni thermocouples. It is for flexible use and fixed installation in dry rooms with medium mechanical load. They may only be installed outdoors with UV- and humidity protection and in observation of the max. permitted temperature range. The steel wire armouring serves as mechanical protection.
